On Wednesday, July 1, Fraser Crossing Partners will conduct urban node construction works at the Agnes Street and Hastings Street intersection. The Project’s urban nodes will be places for people who are walking, cycling or rolling to stop and enjoy, with benches, lighting, bike racks, and landscaping.

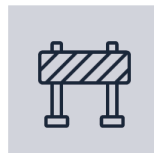
