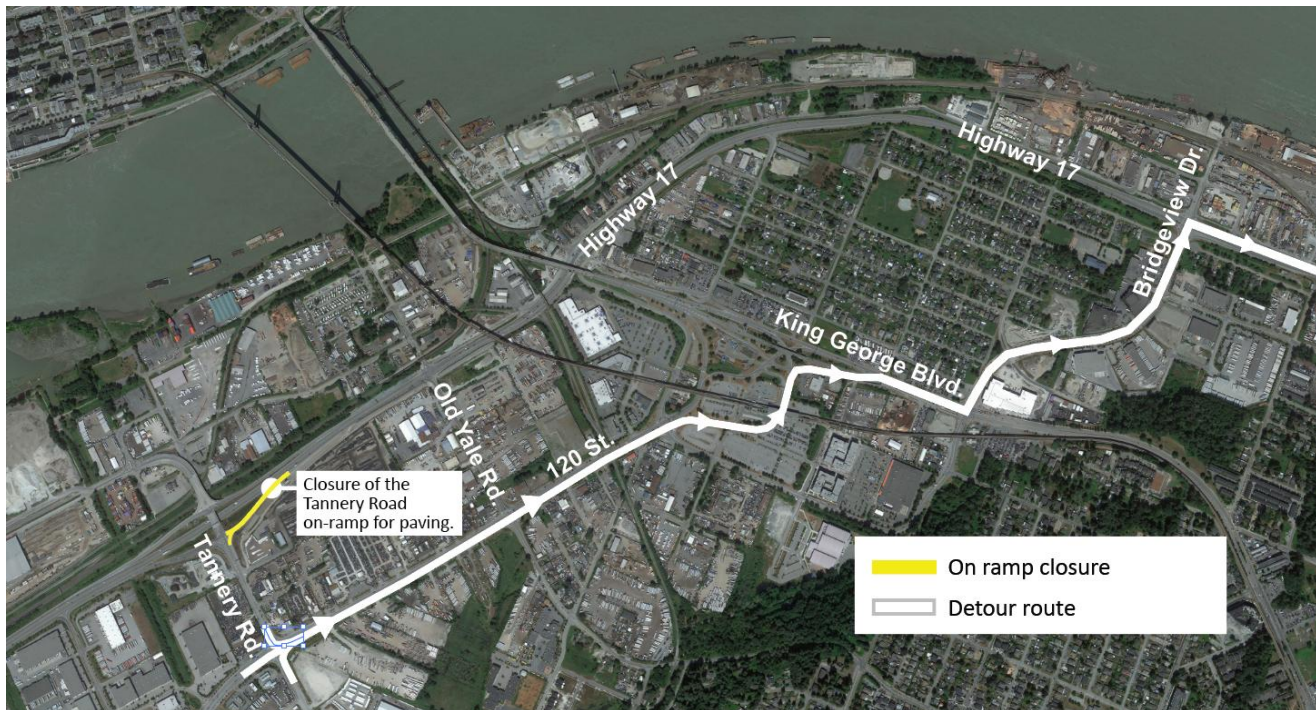
Overnight closures of Tannery on-ramp to Highway 17 eastbound

August 10, 2026

Fraser Crossing Partners will be completing top lift paving works on the Tannery on-ramp to Highway 17 eastbound the nights of Friday, August 14 and Saturday, August 15 from 9 p.m. to approximately 5 a.m.

To complete this work, a closure of the Tannery on-ramp to Highway 17 eastbound will be required. This work is weather dependent. Confirmation will be communicated in advance via road signage and posted on drivebc.ca.

Drivers travelling westbound on 104 Avenue or in either direction on Tannery Road wanting to access Highway 17 eastbound will be detoured to 120 Street to King George Boulevard, and Bridgeview Drive (see graphic below for reference).

Westbound drivers on 104 Avenue or either direction on Tannery Road wanting to access Highway 17 eastbound can take 120 Street to King George Boulevard, and Bridgeview Drive.

All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.
