



Overnight closures of Bridge Connector and Royal Avenue on-ramp for construction of Agnes-Royal multi-use path overpass

July 31, 2026

Starting the night of Friday, August 7, crews will conduct weather dependent concrete pours on the Agnes-Royal multi-use path overpass. Traffic will be maintained on the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge during this work, though some overnight closures of the Bridge Connector and Royal Avenue on-ramp are required from 9 p.m. to approximately 5 a.m.

Overnight closure of Bridge Connector in both directions See map #1 for reference	Friday, August 7 at 9 p.m. to Saturday, August 8 at approximately 5 a.m.	Drivers travelling southbound on the stal'əwasəm Bridge can take the Royal Avenue on-ramp or 6th Avenue to 6th Street, to Royal Avenue. Trucks travelling southbound will not have access to the stal'əwasəm Bridge. stal'əwasəm Bridge users travelling northbound will be detoured to the East Columbia off-ramp. Northbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted via East Columbia Street. Access for emergency responders on Bridge Connector will not be maintained.
Overnight closures of Royal Avenue on-ramp See map #2 for reference	Monday, August 10 at 9 p.m. to Tuesday, August 11 at approximately 5 a.m. Additional dates to be confirmed.	Drivers using the Royal Avenue on-ramp to the stal'əwasəm Bridge can take 6th Street to 6th Avenue, and McBride Boulevard to Bridge Connector. Access for emergency responders will not be maintained on the Royal Avenue on-ramp.

Some overnight intermittent single-lane closures on Bridge Connector will also be required throughout the week of August 10. One lane in each direction will be maintained.

All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.

Following completion of concrete pours over the Royal Avenue on-ramp and Bridge Connector, additional intermittent single-lane closures in each direction on Bridge Connector will be required for finishing works on the Agnes-Royal multi-use path overpass.
