

Overnight closure of East Columbia off-ramp from the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge

August 28, 2026

On Friday, September 4, an overnight closure of the East Columbia off-ramp will be in place. A crane will be positioned on the off-ramp to complete finishing works in the area.

Drivers travelling northbound on the stal'əwasəm Bridge will be detoured to the Royal Avenue off-ramp on to McBride Boulevard to East Columbia Street (see map on the right).

Access for emergency responders will not be maintained on the East Columbia off-ramp but will be available via the Royal Avenue off-ramp detour. Commercial vehicles will be detoured to designated truck routes. Access for cyclists and pedestrians on the east multi-use path on the stal'əwasəm Bridge will be maintained.

Drivers travelling northbound on the stal'əwasəm Bridge can take the Royal Avenue off-ramp on to McBride Boulevard to East Columbia Street. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours.

Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with construction activities.
