



Overnight Bridge Connector lane closures and Royal Avenue on-ramp closures for finishing works on multi-use path overpass

September 14, 2026

Crews will be conducting finishing works on the Agnes-Royal multi-use path overpass the week of September 21, including electrical and drainage installation.

Some overnight single-lane closures on Bridge Connector will be required starting Monday, September 21 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. for approximately two nights. One lane in each direction will be maintained.

Overnight closures of the Royal Avenue on-ramp will be required starting Monday, September 21 between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. for approximately three nights. Drivers using the Royal Avenue on-ramp to the stal'awəsəm (Riverview) Bridge can instead take 6th Street to 6th Avenue, and McBride Boulevard to Bridge Connector.

Access for emergency responders will not be maintained on the Royal Avenue on-ramp but will be available via the McBride Boulevard-Bridge Connector detour. Commercial vehicles will be detoured to designated truck routes.

All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.

Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with construction activities.

Timing

Bridge Connector lane closures: Starting the night of Monday, September 21, for approximately two nights.

Royal Avenue on-ramp closures: Starting the night of Monday, September 21, for approximately three nights.



Hours of Work

Bridge Connector: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Royal On-Ramp: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

Drivers using the Royal Avenue on-ramp can take 6th Street to 6th Avenue, and McBride Boulevard to Bridge Connector.

One lane maintained in each direction on Bridge Connector.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours.

Nearby residents may hear noise associated with construction activities.

No impacts to multi-use paths.
